

## SHAC MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at approximately 12:05 p.m.

The Video Education Subcommittee reported on new sex education videos for Junior High. The subcommittee felt that although the *Understanding HIV & AIDS* DVD promoted abstinence, it was not strong enough at encouraging students to avoid getting the virus. They felt it should be supplemented with a video focusing more on AIDS rather than HIV. The committee felt that the other videos were good to use except for *Skills for Healthy Living* which could be used for counseling students who are already pregnant. Bonnie Peterson motioned to accept the videos for student viewing. Madeline Rother seconded the motion. The motion carried. Also, a suggestion was made to send out an informational letter to parents with questions to discuss about sex with their children at home after viewing the video at school.

A motion was made by Madeline Rother to update the 4<sup>th</sup> grade girl's maturation class to include information on puberty and the female reproductive system. The motion was seconded by Bonnie Peterson. Motion carried and information will be presented to the PISD Board.

An outline of the talk Dr. Pappas has presented to local schools was handed out. The committee will look at the handouts and vote via e-mail or phone whether they would like Dr. Pappas to present the talk to the High School. Upcoming events for PISD and the community were discussed.

Coach Figirova added that East Side is doing NFL Play 60 AHA. The students are to play 60 minutes a day (which includes PE time) and write it down in a planner. If they are able to participate for 28 days, the AHA will send two Houston Texans to talk to the students.

The next SHAC meeting will be April 13, 2010.
